

Addition Practice Worksheet

Count 5 more
after 42.
So the answer
is 47

$$42 + 5 = 47$$

$$\begin{array}{cccccc} 42 & 43 & 44 & 45 & 46 & 47 \\ & 1 & 2 & 3 & 4 & 5 \end{array}$$



But what will you do if you have to add $5 + 66$. You don't need to add 6, 7, 8, 9, ... All the way to 71.

You have to put the bigger number first.

$$5 + 66 = 71$$

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$$66 \ 67 \ 68 \ 69 \ 70 \ 71$$

We got the same answer.

That means $5 + 66 = 66 + 5$

Now your turn. Just try these simple exercise

$$7 + 45 = \boxed{52} \quad 4 + 56 = \boxed{60} \quad 9 + 87 = \boxed{96}$$

$$45 + 7 = \boxed{52} \quad 56 + 4 = \boxed{60} \quad 87 + 9 = \boxed{96}$$

$$3 + 97 = \boxed{100} \quad 2 + 68 = \boxed{70} \quad 3 + 36 = \boxed{39}$$

$$97 + 3 = \boxed{100} \quad 68 + 2 = \boxed{70} \quad 36 + 3 = \boxed{39}$$
