

# Addition Practice Worksheet

Count 5 more  
after 42.  
So the answer  
is 47

$$42 + 5 = 47$$

42 43 44 45 46 47  
1 2 3 4 5



But what will you do if you have to add  $5 + 66$ . You don't need to add 6, 7, 8, 9, ... All the way to 71.

You have to put the bigger number first.

$$5 + 66 = 71$$

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66 67 68 69 70 71

We got the same answer.

That means  $5 + 66 = 66 + 5$

Now your turn. Just try these simple exercise

$7 + 45 = \square$

$4 + 56 = \square$

$9 + 87 = \square$

$45 + 7 = \square$

$56 + 4 = \square$

$87 + 9 = \square$

$3 + 97 = \square$

$2 + 68 = \square$

$3 + 36 = \square$

$97 + 3 = \square$

$68 + 2 = \square$

$36 + 3 = \square$
