HERE'S A PIECE OF THE MULTIPLICATION TABLE. THE DARKER TOP AND SIDE NUMBERS ARE WHAT YOU ARE MULTIPLYING. SO IF I ASKED WHAT IS 5×4 ? YOU WOULD FIND WHERE 5 AND 4 CROSS, WHICH EQUALS 20. IF YOU LOOK CLOSELY YOU WILL SEE THEY CROSS SOMEWHERE ELSE TOO.
